1.	Belief in the Life, Death, & Resurrection of Jesus Christ "Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David" (2 Tim. 2:8a)		
	Servant Leaders who lead Church Meetings are called to be reminders that the "" of ministry programs and preferences is a part of ministry life. Therefore, a ministry plan's from death is a part of our in Jesus Christ.		
2. Acceptance & Teaching of the Gospel "This is my gospel" (2 Tim. 2:8b)
